We have completed an analysis of our courts and have decided to have the lights illuminated at the courts. The developer of this community did not install the transformer necessary to light the courts. Georgia Power has explored several options for this endeavor and has come up with the best and economical plan to install the necessary equipment. This will be a cost of approximately \$1,450.00. Special thanks to Lisa Williams, one of our homeowners, who initiated the engineer’s study of this project. Once the lights are operational, a timer will be in place for optimal energy conservation. Further information will be provided as this project gets underway.

Please walk on sidewalks (where available). Now that it is dark in the mornings and earlier in the evenings, it is for the safety of those of you who walk, as well as the person driving.

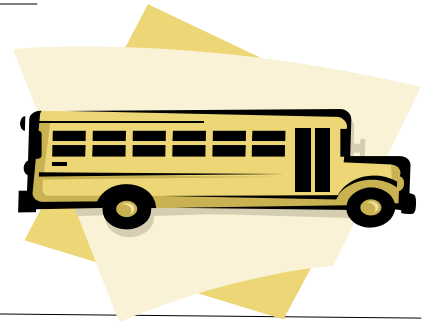
Gate openings for school buses
